

SHENANDOAH VALLEY RIDING CLUB MINUTES OF JUNE 7TH MEETING

The meeting was called to order by President Bud Purvis. Members in attendance were: Glenn Hutcheson, Tammi Lafferty, Rena' Martin, Bud Purvis, Gail Purvis, George Pahoundis, Brian Zuess, Amy Zuess, James Hayhurst, Carol Hayhurst and Liz Purvis.

There was no official treasurer's report available.

The minutes from the prior meeting were also not available.

It was reported that the June 6th show brought a profit of \$130.00 after all expenses had been paid. The concession stand did fairly well and the majority of the food purchased was sold. Everyone agreed that the show on June 6th went really well and that there were no real issues and/or concerns regarding operations! Thanks to all who helped in any way at all!

Liz completed the IBRA paperwork and took care of getting the results submitted.

We discussed the possibility of holding a Fun Show on Friday June 12th. After much discussion, we ultimately decided that with State Fair try-outs being held on Saturday, that this would not be a feasible or lucrative show. With such short notice and the knowledge of the above referenced, as well as not having a tractor readily available for the arena on Friday evening.

We then moved to discussion of doing an Open Show on Saturday June 13th. There were several ideas placed on the floor with regard to such.

1. The fact that there are no shows scheduled locally.
2. Whether or not we could "pull it off" back to back with our last show.
3. Who would be available to help with the show.
4. Would we have the needed equipment to work the arena.
5. How we would set the classes and paybacks.

Liz offered the formula of adding so much money per class depending on the number of entries in each class. After everyone voiced their opinions, there was a motion made by Liz and seconded by George P., which was that we have a show on June 13th. The members present voted in favor of having the show.

Rena' is to compose the showbill and forward it to all who have email addresses on record, as well as to Ellen McKee with a request for her to forward to all contacts that she sees fit. It will also be added to the new website www.svridingclub.com This show will not be a SVRC points show.

In the absence of Greg and his handy tractor for June 13th, George was asked about the possibility of using his tractor. He was more than willing to have his tractor available to drag the arena. Thank you George, you are a show saver!

We also set 2 dates for fun shows. Those dates are June 26th and July 17th. Liz made the motion on the dates and it was seconded by Amy Zuess. Members present voted in agreement of those dates being set for Fun Shows. Liz is working on the classes to be included and as soon as those are decided, the information will be published on the website.

Tammi asked for clarification on what rule we are using regarding obstacles knocked during a class. Glenn agreed that there needed to be further clarification. It was discussed and agreed upon that the rule has always been as follows: an obstacle knocked is a NT and that we will continue using that rule. Any obstacle knocked will result in a NT regardless of whether or not the announcer gives the time to the participant. A NT will result in one (1) participation point being given if it is in a SVRC point eligible class.

There was also clarification of a previous motion regarding Small Fry and Youth declaring where they want their points to count. On show day the issue was that some did not want to declare until the end of the season. Upon looking over minutes from prior meetings, it was found that the motion at the February 15th meeting was as follows: If a member and running in both Small Fry and Youth divisions, you must clarify in which class you want your points to be kept. That motion was made by Rena' Martin and seconded by Glenn Hutcheson. Motion passed with no objections noted. The motion will stand as voted on.

We discussed what days would be the best for everyone to attend regular meetings. After much discussion, Brian Zuess made a motion to hold meetings on the 1st Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at the clubhouse. Seconded by Rena'~ motion passed. The proper procedure will be followed in order to make this change legal.

The next regularly scheduled meeting of SVRC will be held on July 7th at 7:00 p.m. at the clubhouse.

Carol had asked Rena' about including information on the website regarding the clubhouse being available for rent, Rena' explained that the info is already there! We will also attempt to have it in the Jeffersonian from time to time.
